There is limited vehicle access at key points for water stops and aid stations. That being said, ARES is going to provide what additional communication coverage we can for this inaugural running event. We are still coordinating with the organizers and learning the geographic and terrain limitations which Chuck N7BV and Ernie W7EWG chortled over during the last ARES meeting. 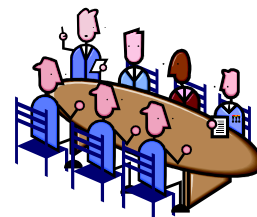
