

The North Olympic Discovery Marathon (NODM) saw amateur radio participation from start to finish to include being written into the Event's Comm Plan. With that success in mind we approached the organizers of the G.O.A.T (Great Olympic Adventure Trail) Marathon to be held in September between Joyce and the Log Cabin Resort at Lake Crescent.

The GOAT is a different sort of animal than the NODM. It is mostly single-file trail over rugged terrain in an area with limited cellphone coverage. There is limited vehicle access at key points for water stops and aid stations. That being said, ARES is going to provide what additional communication coverage we can for this inaugural running event. We are still coordinating with the organizers and learning the geographic and terrain limitations which Chuck N7BV and Ernie W7EWG chortled over during the last ARES meeting.
