***** Amateur Radio Classes and Test Session

Anyone interested in earning an entry level Technician

Anyone interested in earning an entry level Technician class (Level 1), or a General class (Level 2) Amateur Radio license is invited to attend three sessions on successive Saturdays, starting Saturday, April 5, 2014, and continuing on April 12 and April 19. Classes start at 9 AM in the training room at the Port Angeles Fire Department, at 5th and Laurel in Port Angeles. The classes run until 5 PM with an hour off for lunch. On April 19, 2014 there will be a short class and re-view in the morning, followed by the Amateur Radio Exam Session at 1 PM. All classes of Amateur Radio licenses tests will be administered. The test session costs \$15.00. The test questions are based on the ARRL (Amateur Radio Relay League) study guides which contain absolutely everything you need to know to take the FCC license exams. The manuals contain all of the actual questions that will appear on the tests.

all of the actual questions that will appear on the tests. Students will learn Rules and Regulations, Basic Elec-tronics, Operating Amateur Radios, and Radio Fre-quency Safety. Those earning an entry level license will be able to communicate with other hams world wide, and to participate in the Amateur Radio Emer-gency Service, an important part of Homeland Secu-rity. There is no cost for the class, which is presented by volunteers from Clallam County Amateur Radio Club, but the test session costs \$15.00 for FCC Processing. The students must purchase an American Radio Re-lay League "Ham Radio License Manual Level I or The ARRL General Class License Manual at a cost of \$29.95. These books are available from the ARRL. All persons testing must satisfy these requirements: - You must supply the examiners with either a Social Security Number (SSN) or an FCC issued Federal Registration Number (FRN). You are encouraged to apply for an FRN prior to the test session if you do not have one. NOTE that you do not need an amateur license to apply. -You must bring a legal photo ID. - I fyou are upgrading a current Amateur License, you must bring a photocopy of your current license that you will turn in to the examiners. For more information, or to register for the class, call Chuck Jones, N7BV, at 360-452-4672 or Dennis Tilton, AD7TV, at 360-452-1217. Pre-registration is not required, but is a good idea!


