After spending some time browsing multiple other ham radio clubs bylaws that our club, the Clallam County Amateur Radio Club, has set up a semi-closed repeater. It is not a fully closed repeater as the by-laws don't specifically state that W7FEL is in fact a closed repeater. A closed repeater is one that is to be used ONLY by hams approved by some governing body. A semi-closed repeater is one that does not need approval for ones use but is known to be "primarily for members use." This terminology is in the CCARC by-laws.

I have heard local hams say W7FEL is known to be a "non -rag chew" repeater. This reputation may be why the Striped Peak W7FEL Echolink and IRLP are not being used by club members. I don't know if anyone has ever been asked to vacate the repeater, but the fact is about the only traffic on the repeater is Tuesday and Thursday nets and ARES drills.

For those in the area that desire a more open repeater we have WF7W (145.130 T100) in the Port Angeles area and K6MBY (444.900 T131.8) in the Sequim area. These two repeaters are often tied together using the Yaesu Wires X feature. The K6MBY repeater has both Echolink and IRLP and anyone is free to use either of these VOIP systems. VE7US in Victoria is also on the 145.130 T114.8. Reg (VE7US) is often out mobile as he goes from one electrical job to another.

For those in Sequim the **VE7RSI** repeater on Salt Spring Island is a fun place to hang out. **VE7RSI's** coverage into Vancouver, BC, the Canadian and San Juan Islands give them a variety of users. Coverage into Port Angeles is somewhat limited as the southern tip of Vancouver Island causes limited signal into Port Angeles.

If a anyone else has a favorite rag chew repeater let me know.
