

Treasurer - As listed in QTC, with PO Box fees upcoming.


Committees:

## Clallam County-to-France QSO on 100 Milliwatts Jess, AF5X



You might be interested in this New Year's Day QSO with F8RZ in Bourg de St. Hilaire, France. This image, copied from the AF5X monitor, shows the French station's last 73 and two subsequent transmissions indicating that he could still print my follow up signals. We began the QSO with **both stations** at 1 watt. We then reduced to 500mW, then, at finals QRP'd to 100 milliwatts!

JT9 (actually JT9-1 in this case) is the latest weak signal program developed by Joe Taylor, K1JT, Emeritus Professor of Physics at Princeton University. BTW, Joe is a Nobel laureate. The JT9 signal has a bandwidth much narrower than JT65HF, the current favorite digital mode. The bandwidth is about twice that of a CW signal, and the program is capable of decoding signals at least 30 dB \*below\* received noise. Working this mode is a hoot!
