Minutes from Dec 2015 accepted as printed in QTC, Moved, Seconded, Carried (MSC).

Treasurer N7BV reports difficulty in obtaining records from previous treasurer, W7EWG/SK, as passwords were not written down. Initial reconcile from bank records shows a minor error, this will be easily dealt with once new software is obtained. An audit was called for, will investigate once data is available.

Report from the Board.

A bill has been presented to the state to ban fireworks from June through September. This ban would adversely affect our ability to raise funds by fireworks sales. Please write your state rep (Kevin Van De Wege for our area) and ask him to help us out!

Should we add 440 MHz digital to the W7FEL repeater? This was rejected as the repeater is only capable of VHF/VHF, UHF/UHF, VHF/UHF, or UHF/VHF. The current configuration stands.

Decision to investigate use of W7EWG callsign for the Forks repeater.

Set up a table at the Home Show 12-13 March. Cost is discounted for the Club. Thanks to Sheldon N7XEI.
